 - All race nomination, acceptance, non-acceptance and scratching fees are set by PRAs and/or Race Clubs, and are passed on to the Owner/s at cost.
 - Interstate or overseas travel; should the horse race interstate or overseas, charges will be passed on in full to owners

4. PROPRIETOR'S ADDITIONAL REMUNERATION AND GRATUITIES (AS PER THE ATA TERMS & CONDITIONS OF TRAINING)
For any horse that is sold and or retired to stud, the Trainer may invoice an additional fee of 10% (plus GST) on any profit over and above the original purchase price of the horse. Any stud deal will also require one transferable lifetime service right which will entitle the trainer as holder of such right to nominate a mare to be provided with a stud service by the horse during each stud season that the Horse is used to provide stud services commercially, free of any service fee.

5. INTEREST
The Proprietor reserves the right to charge interest on any overdue Training Fees and/or Training Disbursements as permitted under the TOR Rules. If charged, it will be charged at the rate of 2% per month compounding for all accounts at 60 or more days overdue.
